



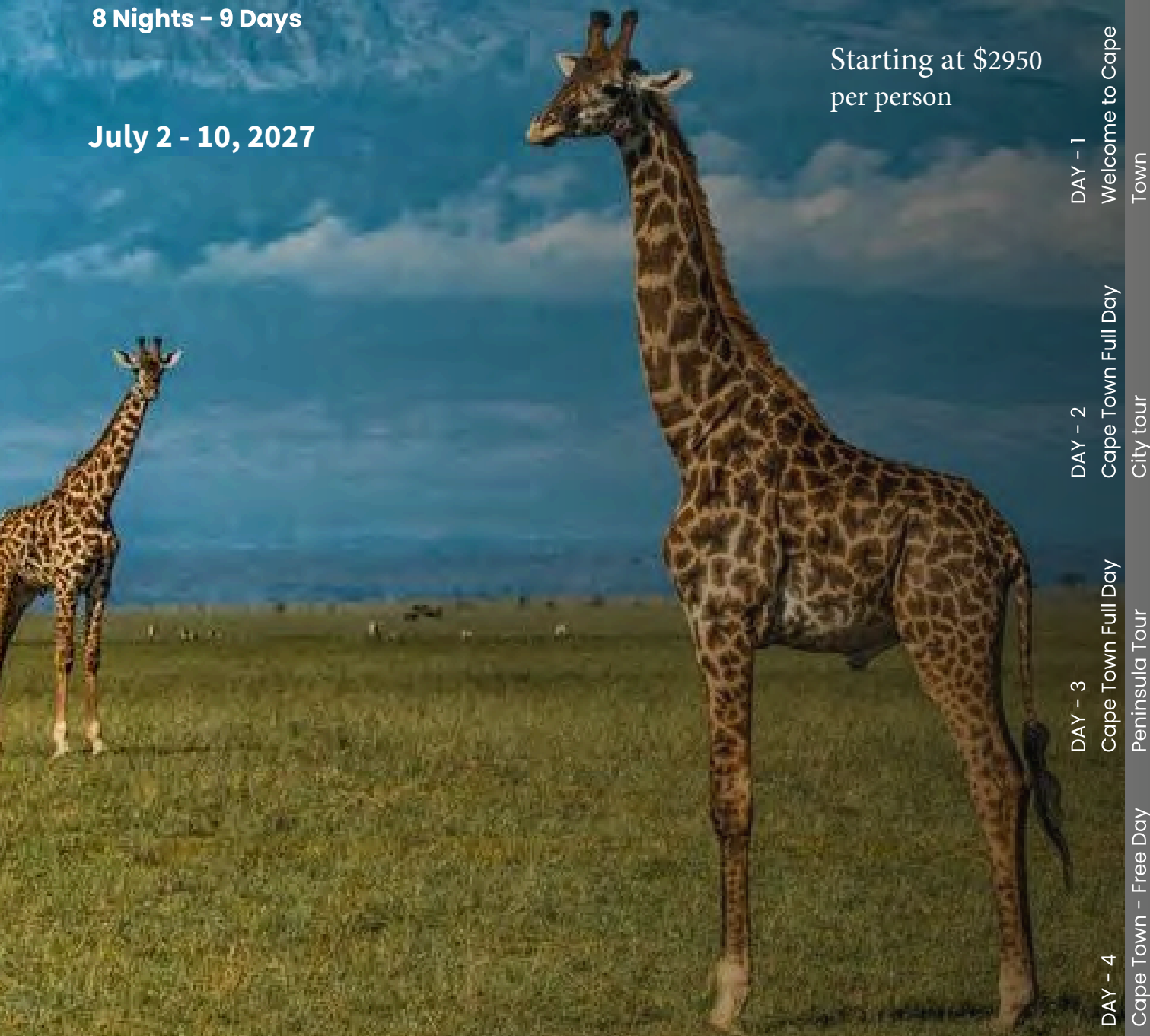

Day 1:

Welcome to Cape Town (CPT)

Walking Level: Relaxed

Highlights: Optional Robben Island tour, explore the Waterfront

Transfers: Airport to Cape Town hotel

On arrival at Cape Town International Airport (flight is excluded) , you will proceed to a COVID-19 screening before passing through customs and collecting your luggage. After passing through the arrivals terminal your guide will meet you with a signage board and proceed to enter the vehicle for the transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Pace of Travel: Relaxed

Steps to Walk: Approx. 1,000–2,000 steps

Facilities: Hotel transfer and hotel amenities

Suitable for Age group: All ages

What to Bring: Comfortable shoes, face mask, camera

What to Do: Optional Robben Island tour, explore the Waterfront

What not to Do: Rush through the tour; take your time to explore the area

Tip for You: If you wish to visit Robben Island, book tickets in advance, especially during peak hours.

Overnight: Cape Town

Transfers: Airport to Cape Town hotel transfer



Day 2 :

Cape Town Full Day City tour

Walking Level: Moderate

Highlights: Table Mountain, City landmarks

Transfers: Hotel to city center

This morning after breakfast you will depart your hotel for your Half Day Table Mountain & City Tour. Our drive to the city center takes us to historical famous landmarks such as the Castle of Good Hope built in 1666 by the Dutch East India Company and City Hall, a baroque building and the Grand Parade. As we follow the city's main thoroughfare, Adderley Street, we will see St. George's Cathedral, the Anglican Diocese of Nobel Peace Laureate Archbishop Desmond Tutu. We will pass the Company Gardens and the Malay Quarter which is also known as the Bo-Kaap which means 'Above Cape' because of its location up against the slopes of Table Mountain. In the early 18th century, thousands of slaves from Java, Ceylon, and other Far Eastern regions were brought to Cape Town. After slavery was abolished, their descendants, known as the Cape Malays, settled here. Continue to join a sparkling tour, and witness the art of diamond cutting and the careful craftsmanship of jewelry manufacturing by skilled experts. Discover the history of the Diamond and Gold Trade in South Africa.

You will be offered the option of continuing to Table Mountain, where you can ascend to the top (if the weather permits) by the revolving cable car. Here, you'll see wildflowers and the famous silver tree and marvel at a birds-eye view of the city and its beaches. On a clear day, it is even possible to see Robben Island where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned on one side and Cape Point on the other.

Tour Duration: 08:30–13:00

Pace of Travel: Moderate

Steps to Walk: Approx. 2,000–3,000 steps

Facilities: City landmarks, transportation between stops

Suitable for Age group: All ages (may include some uneven surfaces)

What to Bring: Comfortable shoes, sunscreen, camera

What to Do: Explore Cape Town's historical landmarks, optional visit to Table Mountain

What not to Do: Skip walking in the Bo-Kaap district; it's part of the city's charm

Tip for You: If you're visiting Table Mountain, be aware of the weather; cable car rides are weather-dependent and are at an extra cost.

Overnight: Cape Town

Meal: Breakfast

Transfers: Hotel to city center



Day 3 :

Cape Town Full Day Peninsula Tour

Walking Level: Moderate

Highlights: Cape Point, Penguin Colony

Transfers: Hotel to attractions and back

This Morning after breakfast you will depart the hotel for your Full Day Peninsula Tour. Bring your camera: we’re headed for Cape Point at the southwestern tip of the Cape Peninsula, and the most spectacular views in the world. The drive there is just as inspiring, passing steep mountains, secluded coves and sweeping beaches, as well as villages and fishing communities.

Our tour begins with a scenic drive along the Atlantic coast, passing through the cosmopolitan suburb of Sea Point and Camps Bay with its glorious views of the Twelve Apostles, part of the Table Mountain range. We’ll continue to the fishing village of Hout Bay, one of Cape Town’s best-kept secrets.

The majestic coastline offers drama worthy of being called ‘Nature’s Greatest Show’. We’ll be able to see the union of the Atlantic and Indian Oceans (as per legend) and may even feel the brisk wind that is dubbed the ‘Cape Doctor’ for its presumed curative powers. Following the coastline along False Bay, we’ll return to Cape Town by way of Simon’s Town, where we visit the Penguin colony at Boulders Beach and Fish Hoek fishing village. Before our return, we’ll stop at Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens for a short walking tour of the beautiful gardens. We return to Cape Town, passing the University of Cape Town, Rhodes Memorial and the Groote Schuur Hospital.

Tour Duration: 08:30–17:00

Pace of Travel: Moderate

Steps to Walk: Approx. 3,000–5,000 steps

Facilities: Rest stops, scenic viewpoints, nature reserve amenities

Suitable for Age group: All ages (some walking on uneven ground at Cape Point and Kirstenbosch)

What to Bring: Comfortable walking shoes, camera, sunscreen, hat

What to Do: Visit Cape Point, Penguin Colony, Kirstenbosch Gardens

What not to Do: Skip taking photos; the views are stunning

Tip for You: Carry some water and snacks for the journey. If you want to visit Seal Island, it’s optional and an additional cost.

Overnight: Cape Town

Meal: Breakfast

Transfers: Hotel to attractions and back



Day 4 :

Cape Town – Free Day

Walking Level: Relaxed

Highlights: Explore local shops, relax

Breakfast at the hotel and spend the day at leisure.

- Pace of Travel:** Relaxed
- Steps to Walk:** Optional (depending on your activities)
- Facilities:** Hotel amenities, leisure facilities
- Suitable for Age group:** All ages
- What to Bring:** Comfortable clothing, hat, sunglasses
- What to Do:** Explore Cape Town at your own pace, visit local shops, relax at the hotel
- What not to Do:** Feel pressured to do too much, enjoy your time off
- Tip for You:** Take this opportunity to discover hidden gems in Cape Town that interest you
- Overnight:** Cape Town
- Meal:** Breakfast



Day 5 :

Cape Town to Kruger by Flight (flight is excluded and depart before 12 PM)

Walking Level: Relaxed

Highlights: Scenic drive

Transfers: Transfer from Cape Town hotel to airport, then to Kruger hotel

After a leisurely breakfast and check-out. Private transfer to Cape Town Airport for your flight to Kruger (flight is excluded).

Arrival at Kruger Mpumalanga Int Airport, after passing through the arrivals terminal your guide will meet you with a signage board and proceed to enter the vehicle for Private transfer to the hotel with Dinner. Rest of the day at leisure.

- Facilities:** Airport transfer, hotel amenities

Day 6 :

Full day Scheduled Game Drive in Kruger National Park

Walking Level: Moderate

Highlights: Full-day game drive

Transfers: Hotel to game drive starting point and back

Breakfast pack at the hotel today – enjoy a Scheduled Full Day Game Drive –Predators like leopards, cheetahs, wild dogs, and lion are Most active during these cooler hours of the day, we safari for around 3 Hours before our breakfast break.

Our guides are all qualified and have years’ worth of experience in the park. They love nothing more than to share their knowledge with you and to make sure that you have the best safari experience possible. Please bring with sun cream, a hat, sunglasses, comfortable shoes, warm clothing in the winter months and a rain jacket in the summer months. Mineral waters are included on all safaris.

Game Drive Duration: 3 Hours (Each Drive)

Dinner will be served back at the hotel.

Pace of Travel: Moderate

Steps to Walk: Approx. 5,000 steps

Facilities: Safari vehicle, packed breakfast, game reserve

Suitable for Age group: All ages, though children should be supervised

What to Bring: Comfortable safari attire, sunscreen, hat, camera, binoculars, jacket for colder mornings

What to Do: Participate in a full-day game drive to spot wildlife, enjoy breakfast in the bush

What not to Do: Leave without your camera or binoculars

Tip for You: Bring a light jacket for early morning game drives and wear neutral colors to blend in with nature

Overnight: Kruger

Meal: Breakfast, Dinner

Transfers: Hotel to game drive starting point and back



Day 7:

Kruger to Johannesburg via Blyde River Canyon

Walking Level: Relaxed

Highlights: Blyde River Canyon

Breakfast at the hotel, pack your bags, and get ready for a drive to Johannesburg. Check in to the hotel and the rest of the day is at leisure on your own.

- Pace of Travel:** Relaxed
- Steps to Walk:** Approx. 3,000 steps
- Facilities:** Transfer, scenic stops
- Suitable for Age group:** All ages
- What to Bring:** Comfortable shoes, camera, sun protection
- What to Do:** Visit Blyde River Canyon, check in to your Johannesburg hotel
- What not to Do:** Rush through the canyon views; take time to appreciate nature
- Tip for You:** Capture the stunning landscapes at Blyde River Canyon
- Overnight:** Johannesburg
- Meal:** Breakfast
- Transfers:** Transfer from Kruger to Johannesburg is included

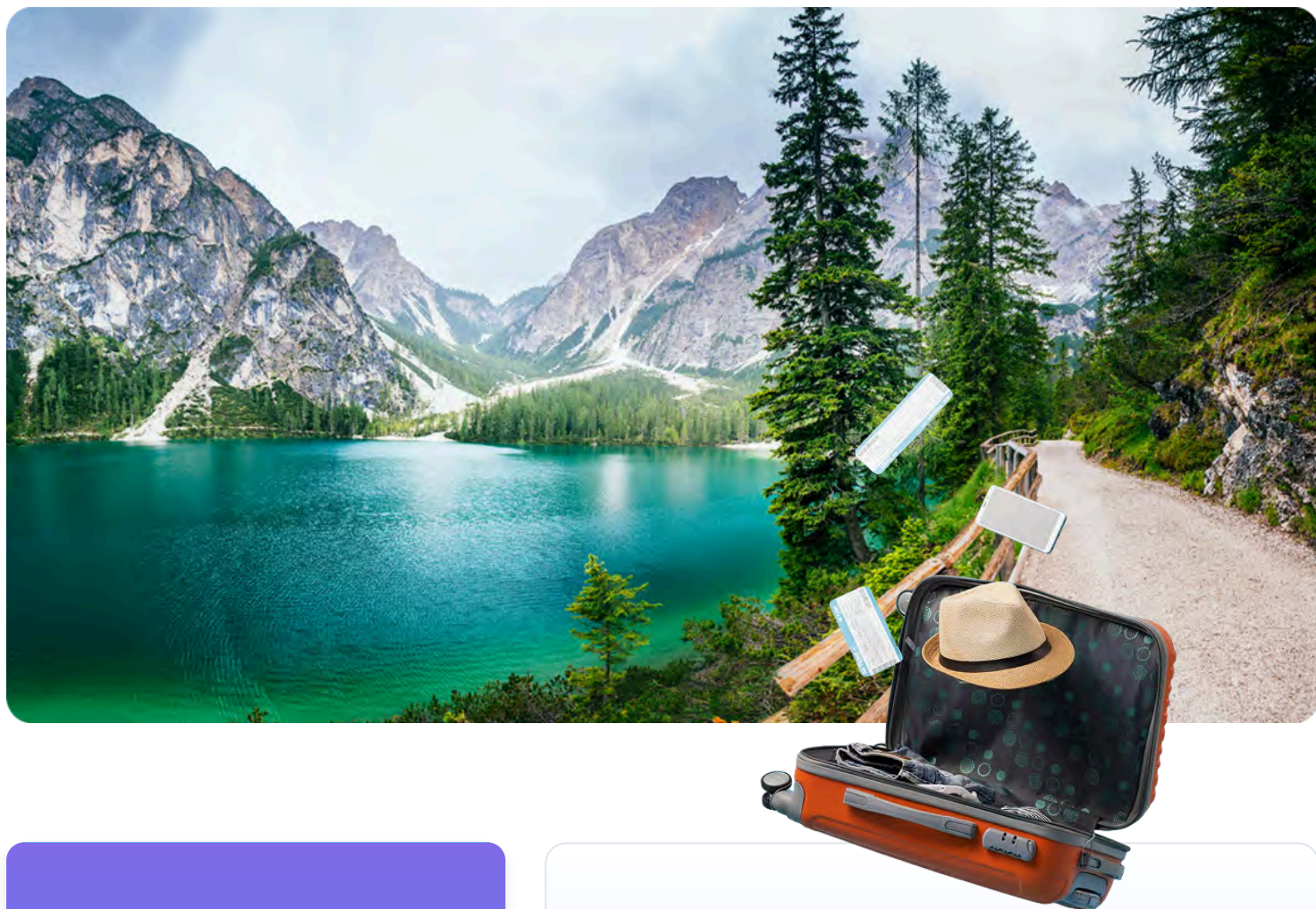
Cancellation Policy
