**Day 1:**

Arrival Cairo (CAI)

**Walking Level:** Relaxed**Highlights:** Hotel check-in**Transfers:** Airport to hotel

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, a representative will warmly welcome you and assist with your transfer to the hotel for check-in. Take this time to unwind and recharge after your journey.

Pace of Travel: Relaxed**Steps to Walk:** Approximately 1,000–1,500**Facilities:** Airport pickup, hotel transfer, hotel amenities, and leisure time at the hotel**Suitable for Age Group:** All ages**What to Bring:** Passport, travel documents, personal essentials**What to Do:** Relax at the hotel after your flight**What not to Do:** Relax and enjoy your time at the hotel, explore the surrounding area at your own pace**Tip for You:** Take it easy today to recover from your journey; acclimatize to the local environment.**Overnight:** Cairo**Transfers:** Transfer from the Airport to the hotel is included.

**Day 2:**

Pyramids & Cairo Sightseeing Tours

**Walking Level:** Moderate**Highlights:** Egyptian Museum, Pyramids, Sphinx**Transfers:** Hotel to sightseeing locations and back

Start your day with breakfast at the hotel. Then, begin your tour with a visit to the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, home to the largest and most valuable collection of Egyptian art in the world. With over 250,000 artifacts, highlights include treasures from the tomb of Tutankhamun, including gold and jewelry that were preserved for over 3,500 years before being discovered in the 1920s.

Next, visit the Great Pyramids of Giza, including the towering Pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinos. The Pyramid of Cheops is the largest and most impressive. End your tour with a close-up view of the Sphinx, the iconic monument with the body of a lion and the face of King Chephren, part of the grand funeral complex.

- What to Do:** Explore the Egyptian Museum, Pyramids of Giza, and Sphinx
- What not to Do:** Do not touch or climb the pyramids
- Tip for You:** Start early to avoid the afternoon heat
- Overnight:** Cairo
- Meal:** Breakfast
- Transfers:** Transfer from the hotel to sightseeing location and back

Fly Cairo to Aswan by Flight – Cruise (Flight is Excluded)

**Walking Level:**

Active in the morning, relaxed in the afternoon

Highlights: Aswan High Dam, Philae Temple, Felucca Ride**Transfers:** Hotel to Cairo Airport, Cairo to Aswan Airport

Begin your day with a delicious breakfast at the hotel and a seamless transfer from your hotel to Cairo Airport for your flight to Aswan. Upon arrival, our representative will assist you before embarking on a fascinating exploration of Aswan High Dam, an engineering marvel built between 1960 and 1970 to control the Nile's floods and generate hydroelectric power.

Next, enjoy a scenic motorboat ride to Philae Island, home to the stunning Philae Temple, dedicated to Isis, the mother of Horus. Surrounded by the tranquil waters of the Nile, this sacred site showcases temples from the Pharaonic, Greek, and Roman eras, offering a glimpse into Egypt's rich history.

After your exploration, transfer to your luxurious Nile cruise and check in for a memorable journey. Savor a delightful lunch on board, and then unwind in the afternoon with a peaceful felucca ride on the Nile (weather permitting). Feel the warmth of the Egyptian sun as you glide across the legendary river, embracing the serenity of this timeless landscape.



Day 3

Steps to Walk: Approximately 5,000–6,000 steps

Facilities: Airport transfer, port transfer, cruise amenities, restrooms at sites

Suitable for Age Group: 10 years and above

What to Bring: Light clothing, sunscreen, camera, snacks

What to Do: Visit Aswan High Dam, Philae Temple, and enjoy a felucca ride

What not to Do: Avoid standing too close to the edge during the felucca ride

Tip for You: Capture sunset views from the felucca for stunning photos

Overnight: Nile Cruise

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Overnight: Cruise

Transfers: Transfer from hotel to Cairo Airport and airport to Aswan High Dam, boat transfers

**Day 4 :****Cruise: Visit Kom Ombo Temple****Walking Level:** Relaxed**Highlights:** Kom Ombo Temple, Crocodile Museum**Transfers:** Nile Cruise

Today, you will slowly sail towards **Kom Ombo Temple**, located on the east bank of the Nile River. Upon arrival, visit the unique double temple, dedicated to both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris. The Greco-Roman temple of Kom Ombo was built between 190 BC and 219 AD. After exploring the temple, visit the nearby Crocodile Museum before returning to your Nile Cruise and continuing your sail to Edfu.



Day 4

- Steps to Walk:** Approximately 4,000–5,000 steps # Facilities: Cruise amenities, restrooms at sites, and sightseeing

- What to Do:** Visit Kom Ombo Temple, Crocodile Museum
- What not to Do:** Avoid wandering off from the guided tour
- Tip for You:** Try Egyptian tea on the cruise sundeck
- Overnight:** Nile Cruise
- Meal:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

**Day 5:****Cruise: Visit Edfu Temple****Walking Level:** Relaxed**Highlights:** Edfu Temple, Horse Carriage Ride**Transfers:** Nile Cruise

On arrival, enjoy a horse & Carriage return trip to **visit Edfu temple**, which is considered the best preserved of all Egypt's temples. The temple of Horus at Edfu was built in the Ptolemaic Kingdom between 237 and 57 BC.

You will enjoy the temple construction as well as the myths of ancient Egypt. Return to your Nile Cruise, free time on board while sailing to Luxor via Esna, and enjoy your afternoon tea on the Cruise sundeck.



Day 5

- What to Do:** Visit Edfu Temple, enjoy afternoon tea on the sundeck
- What not to Do:** Do not litter or damage historical artifacts
- Tip for You:** The horse carriage ride is a great way to see the local scenery
- Overnight:** Nile Cruise
- Meal:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
- Transfers:** Horse carriage, cruise



Day 6 : Luxor – Cairo by Flight (Flight is Excluded)

Walking Level: Active

Highlights: Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple, Karnak Temple, Luxor Temple

Transfers: Hotel to sightseeing locations and Luxor Airport

After breakfast, check out and embark on an unforgettable journey across the West Bank of Luxor. Begin your exploration at the Valley of the Kings, where you'll step into the ancient tombs of Egypt's mighty pharaohs. Continue to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, an architectural masterpiece dedicated to Egypt's first female ruler. Pause at the Colossi of Memnon, two towering statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III that have stood the test of time.

Next, visit the awe-inspiring Karnak Temple, the largest religious site in Egypt. Walk through the grand Avenue of Sphinxes and immerse yourself in the incredible history of this vast complex, dedicated to the god Amun-Ra. Conclude your tour at the Luxor Temple, situated in the heart of the city, once connected to Karnak by a 3-kilometer-long ceremonial path lined with sphinxes.

Later in the afternoon, transfer to Luxor Airport for your flight back to Cairo, where our representative will meet and assist you before transferring you to your hotel.

Facilities: Restrooms at sites, sightseeing, airport transfer

Suitable for Age Group: 10+ (due to extensive walking)

What to Do: Explore Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple, Karnak Temple, and Luxor Temple

What not to Do: Avoid entering tombs without a guide's permission

Tip for You: The avenue of sphinxes offers great photo opportunities—don't miss it!

Transfers: Transfer from hotel to sightseeing location and to Luxor Airport, Cairo Airport to hotel transfer.

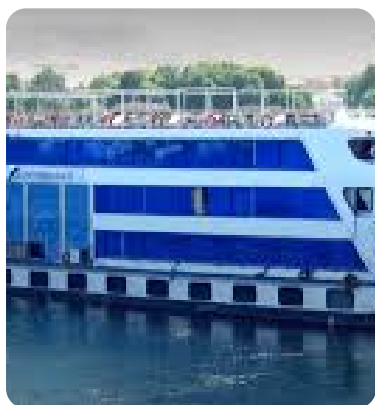

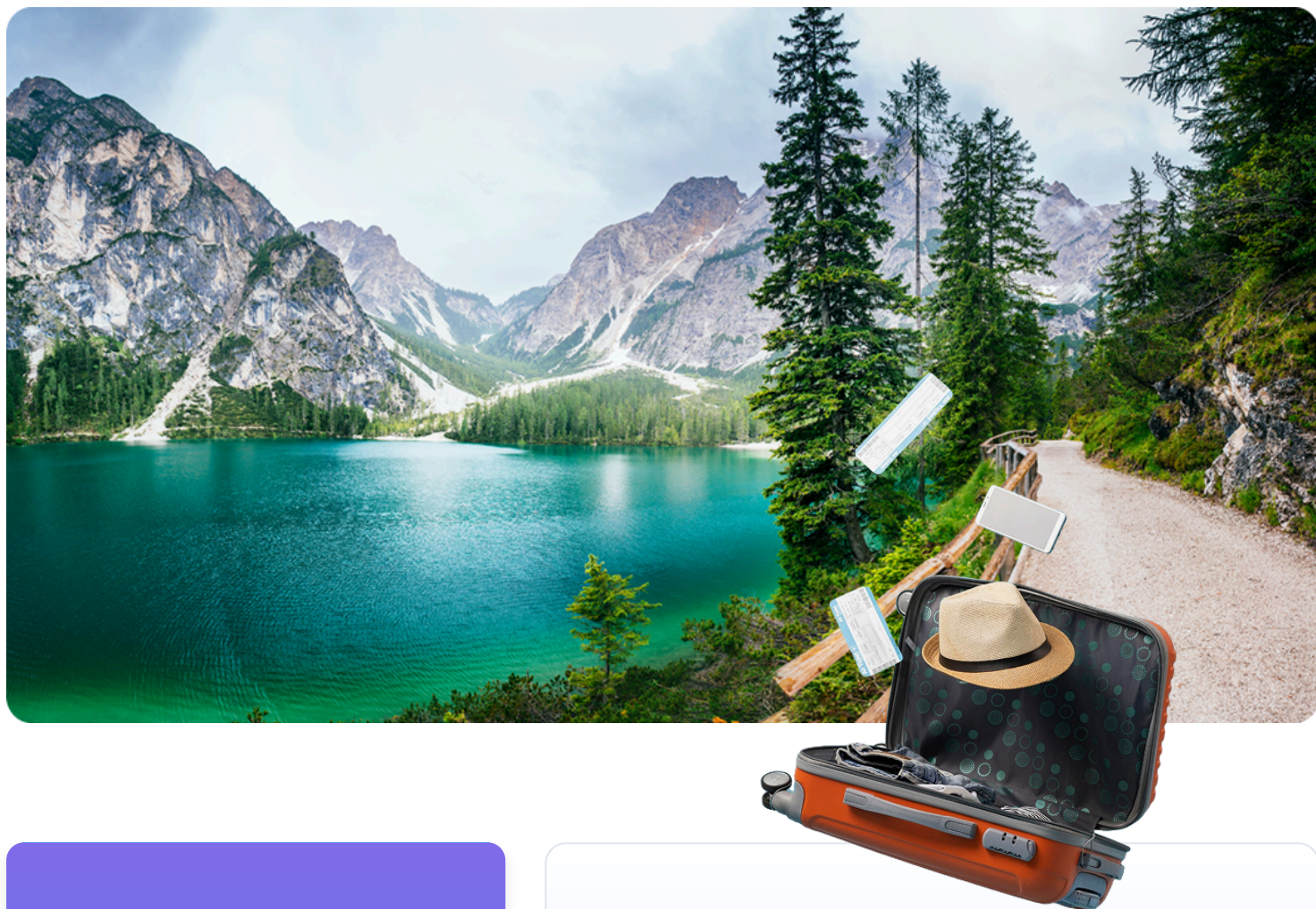
Cancellation Policy
