## City and Temple Tour – The Royal Grand Palace and the Emerald Buddha

**Walking Level:** Moderate**Highlights:** Wat Traimit, Wat Arun, Wat Pho, Grand Palace**Transfers:** Hotel to attractions and return

After breakfast at the hotel, you will begin your sightseeing tour. Your tour begins at Wat Traimit, the temple of the Golden Buddha; the 900-year-old, five-and-a-half-ton solid gold image. After this, you continue on to visit Wat Arun, better known as the Temple of the Dawn, which is one of the best-known and most published landmarks of Bangkok. Next, you will visit Wat Pho, the largest and oldest temple in Bangkok, and also the temple holding the largest single Buddha image; the Reclining Buddha (Phra Buddhasaiyas). This temple is also known as the birthplace of Thai traditional massage.

We will go for lunch at a local restaurant, after which, we will continue on to visit some of the most famous tourist spots in Bangkok; the Royal Grand Palace and the Emerald Buddha. The Grand Palace adjoins Wat Phra Kaew in a common compound and is where you will end up after exiting Wat Phra Kaew. Despite the proximity of the two, there is a distinct contrast in style between the very Thai Wat Phra Kaew and the more European-inspired designs of the Grand Palace.

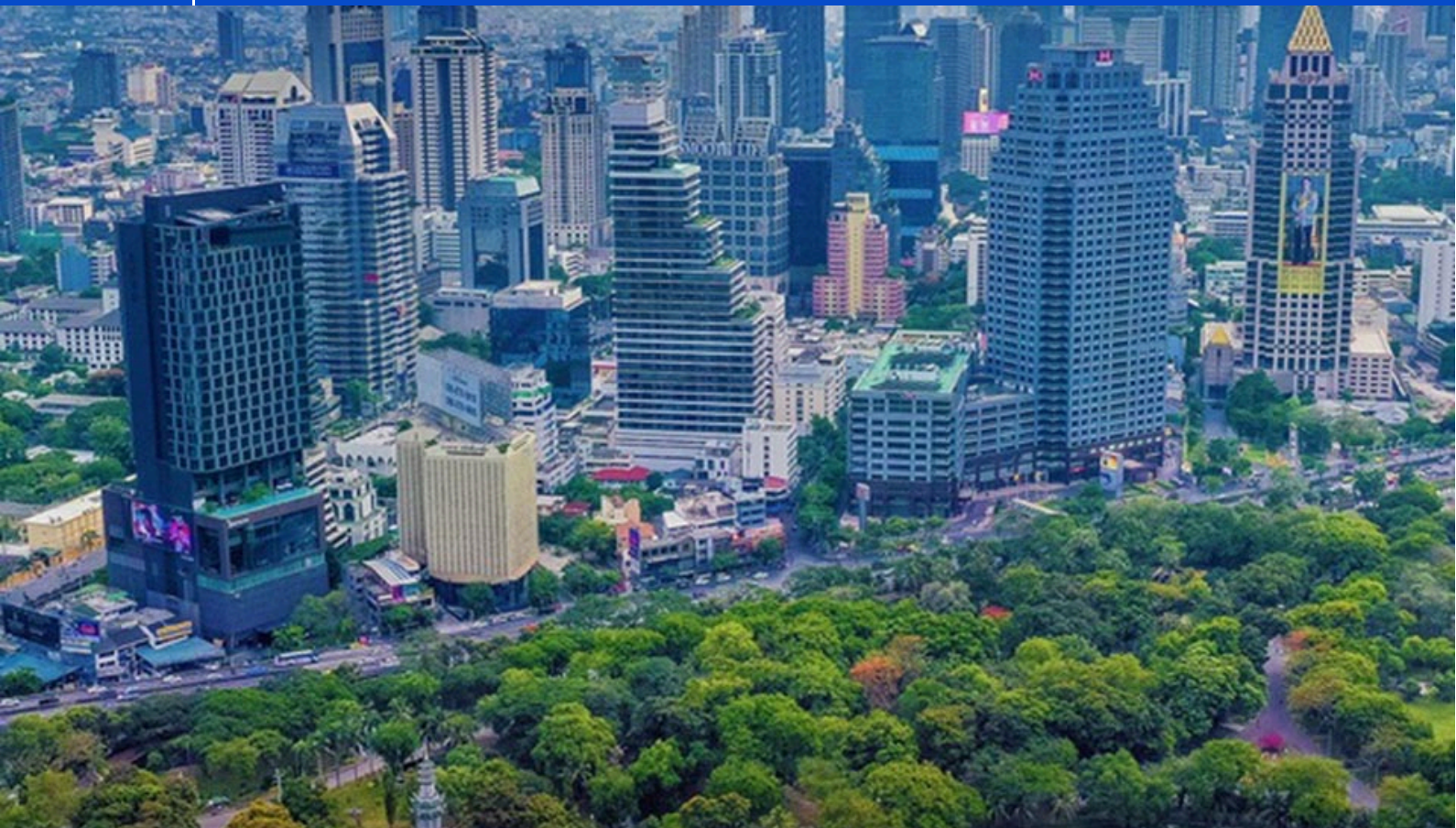

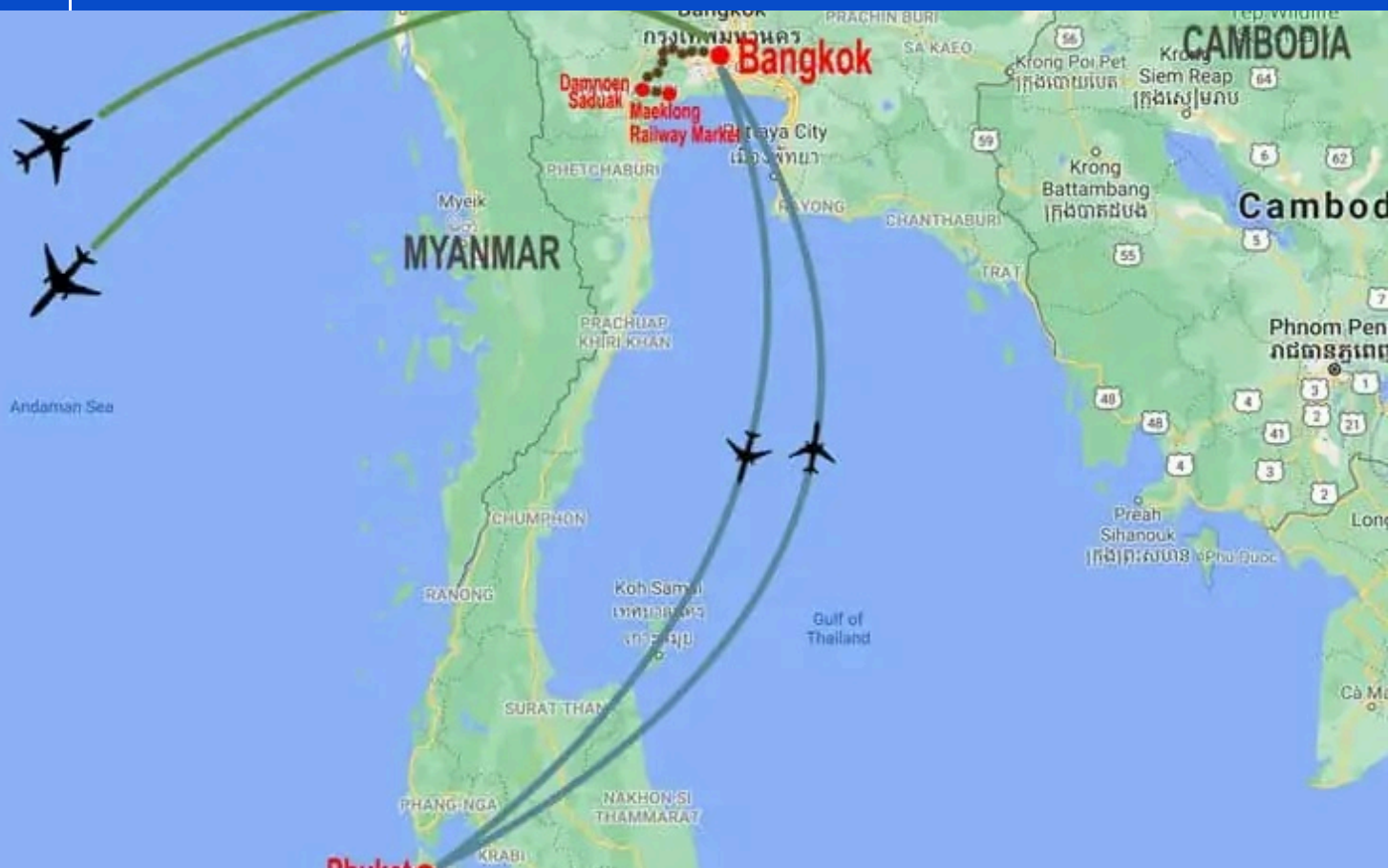

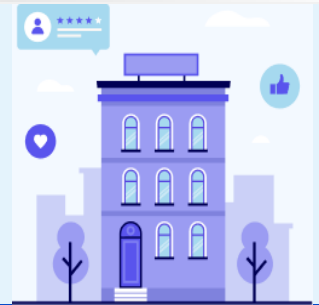
